Rohan McCullough tells the tale of the author Beatrix Potter, the woman behind the children’s stories. Based on Beatrix Potter’s diaries, Rohan takes us on an enchanting journey through the storyteller’s life, from her solitary childhood and conflicts with her parents, to the success of Peter Rabbit and an unlikely but happy marriage.

Rohan McCullough trained for the stage at The Bristol Old Vic Theatre School and began her career in the original cast of Hair and Jean-Louis Barrault’s Rabelais. More recently she has been seen as Antigone in Oedipus at Colonnus (Manchester Royal Exchange) and Mme. de Volanges in Les Liaisons Dangereuses (RSC). She has given poetry and music recitals at the Victoria and Albert Museum, the South Bank and the Wigmore Hall. Rohan has performed as narrator with leading American Symphony Orchestras, including the Los Angeles Philharmonic and The Boston Symphony at Carnegie Hall.

Her TV and film credits include Sunday Bloody Sunday, Dealers and A Dance To The Music Of Time, David Hare’s Strapless and Derek Jarman’s War Requiem. She has achieved her most notable success with her one woman shows.
